Dear Judge Sinatra,

In accordance with your Court Order dated April 23, 2025, Mr. Wenke was committed to the custody of the Bureau of Prisons (BOP) pursuant to Title 18 U.S.C. § 4244. Such a commitment constitutes a provisional sentence of imprisonment to the maximum term authorized by law for his violations of the terms of his Supervised Release. The BOP Designation and Sentence Computation Center has calculated Mr. Wenke's Projected Release Date to be October 7, 2025, based upon his reaching the maximum term from his violation.

Consistent with 18 U.S.C. § 4246, Mr. Wenke's dangerousness was evaluated as he was an inmate at the completion of his sentence. BOP staff determined he does not meet the criteria for civil commitment and a certificate of dangerousness will not be filed. Thus, the BOP will release Mr. Wenke from custody on October 7, 2025. Upon release from FMC Devens, Mr. Wenke will be supervised by the Western District of New York, U.S. Probation Office under the remaining terms of supervision from his prior offense.
